To enable Club duties to be spread fairly between our Members, the Club expects that each Membership type will have at least one Race Officer or Safety Boat driver/assistant amongst them. If you currently do not hold these skills, we will help you achieve this. During the year we run Club Race Officer and RYA Powerboat courses, on completion of either of these we will assign you a duty. There is an initial fee for attending either course of £40 (this fee is charged at the time of joining the Club). Once completed and you have fulfilled a duty, this fee will be credited against next year’s Membership fee.
