



## Galley Slave Duty Tasks

---

The duty on a normal club day could involve the following tasks:

### Serving Club Members

---

- Taking money
- Adding up
- Giving change
- Preparing and serving hot drinks
- Taking and writing food orders
- Giving out hot/cold food
- Serving ice lollies and ice creams
- Serving drinks from the bar
- Refilling milk jug/sugar basin as appropriate

### Preparing food/drinks

---

- Filling the confectionary cabinet
- Making filter coffee
- Washing and preparing salad/vegetables
- Making filled rolls
- Restocking the chilled cabinets with drinks
- Refilling sauce bottles and cruets

### Clearing up

---

- Collecting crockery/glasses
- Filling and emptying dishwasher
- Filling and emptying glass machine
- Putting away clean items to their usual place
- Wiping surfaces
- Washing pots

### Note

---

- You will not be expected to cook food but offers to assist are appreciated
- On Wednesday evenings you may be asked to help set out tables and chairs as well as put on and take off table cloths
- On special events such as open day, club bbq etc., you may be asked to help with the bbq or be a 'go between' to ferry food between kitchen and bbq
- If you are uncomfortable with any task, please discuss as it may be possible for you to concentrate on one of the others
- If you need to change or amend your duty, please discuss with Sarah
- Duties on average last 4 – 5 hours
- Please do not bring children into the kitchen as it is not safe to do so
- For health & safety reasons, please do not wear open sandals or trainers
- This list is not exhaustive but gives a guide of the tasks involved
