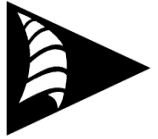




# SPINNAKER CLUB



## APPLICATION FOR MEMBERSHIP

### Club Rules:

Spinnaker Club operates within a set of Rules and Constitution, which were revised in December 2005 and are available in the Clubhouse. Associated with the Constitution are Byelaws, which cover general and safety issues. These Byelaws are currently published in the Year Book as General and Safety Rules and are also available in the Clubhouse. The following rules have been abstracted from the Year Book because they may be relevant to your application:

1. Personal safety is the direct responsibility of the person using the lake.
2. Swimming is not allowed in the lake.
3. Young persons under 16 years old are not allowed to be at the club unless accompanied and supervised by an adult club member.
4. All crafts using the lake must have adequate insurance, to include minimum third party cover of £2,000,000.
5. A rowing boat and the blue start boat are normally left ready to go at all times for use in an emergency. – check it is ready to use before sailing and its use is at your own risk. (Members are warned that the Club is only able to provide rescue facilities during the hours of racing and during organised training sessions. )
6. All dinghies in the dinghy park must be adequately tied down (to the chain where provided) to prevent movement in strong winds.

### Member's duties:

Spinnaker Club is run by voluntary effort and it is expected that members will undertake duties assisting with the Sunday racing.

### Declarations:

1. I/we wish to sail the craft listed overleaf and declare that such craft is/are insured against Third Party Risks for general sailing and racing in accordance with RYA recommendations. This insurance is a condition of membership for all sailing at the club
2. I/We declare that I /we have read and fully understand the information leaflet "Blue Green Algae – The Facts". In the event of any loss, damage, personal injury or death arising from contact with the water, I /we understand that the Spinnaker Club will not be liable for costs or damages, because I /we have accepted the risks associated with Blue Green Algae.
3. I/we understand the Club is run by voluntary effort and that it is expected that members will undertake duties assisting with the Sunday racing.
4. I/we declare we have read the abstract of the Rules given above and agree to abide by the entire Club Constitution and Rules, which are available in the clubhouse.
5. I/we agree to the Club secretary holding personal records on a database for as long as I/we am/are a member. A print out of the data held is available on request.

Membership runs from 1<sup>st</sup> January to 31<sup>st</sup> December. Half annual fees apply for members elected after 1<sup>st</sup> September for 2010. Members elected after 1<sup>st</sup> November 2010 shall pay full fee but this shall cover membership and boat parking (where applicable) for 2011.

ADULT MEMBER - being a person who, at the date of election, is aged eighteen or over.
FAMILY MEMBER - which expression shall include a family unit comprising at least one parent, their spouse or partner residing at the same address (as may be) and all children under eighteen years of age at the date of election. See note regarding persons under 16 years below
JUNIOR MEMBER - being a person who, at the date of election, and on each successive January 1 <sup>st</sup> is aged less than 18 years. Such member shall have no vote. If under the age of 16 years, a Junior Member application shall be sponsored by an Adult Member and the Junior shall be in the care of a responsible Adult Member at all times whilst on the Club premises. Junior membership is intended for people aged 18 or under on 1st January who are accompanied by a non-family member on a regular basis where the parent or guardian does not attend the club at all. An example of this could be a junior crew in a double handed boat who crews for someone other than the parent or guardian.
SOCIAL MEMBER - an adult not wishing to sail. The category of "social" is for non sailing members. It is NOT available as an Adult membership option as an addition to Junior membership to enable that junior member to sail. Family membership is the appropriate category for this.
* <u>Note regarding Members aged under 16 years.</u> All children aged under 16 years whilst at the club must be accompanied and supervised by an Family/Adult Member over the age of 18 or a responsible Adult Member (not being a Social Member) who has the authority of the Adult Member who sponsored their application or membership renewal.
